

#### **CHART STRUCTURE**

Analyzing chart structure will help you to see overall patterns of energy and how energy is expressed in a natal chart.



**Zodiac signs:** Every planet, node or point in the chart is located in one of the 12 zodiac signs.

**Planets:** Each planet, including the Sun, Moon and Chiron represent a particular human drive.

**Houses:** Each of the 12 houses represents a particular area of life experience.

**Nodes:** Symbolizes gifts brought into this life; the past and lessons to come; the future.

**Ascendant:** Represents birth and new beginnings.

**Descendant:** Represents relationships.

**Aspects:** Relationships between planets and other points. The Aspects show how the energies connect - harmoniously or pushing.\*\*

MC: Symbolizes career and accomplishments. \*\*

IC: Symbolizes roots, home and family. \*\*

#### **ABOVE-HORIZON DOMINANT PLACEMENTS**

#### Are there more planets above the horizon?

If there are more planets above the horizon, especially personal planets, this person tends to be more extroverted and wants to work with groups, others and in the public eye.

#### **BELOW-HORIZON DOMINANT PLACEMENTS**


#### Are there more planets below the horizon?

If there are more planets below the horizon, especially personal planets, this person tends to be more introverted and private.

#### **BALANCED PLACEMENTS**

### Are there equal planets placed in both hemisphere?

This person has a balance of extroverted and introverted expression of energy.



#### LEFT-SIDE DOMINANT PLACEMENTS


### Are there more planets placed on the left side of the chart?

If there are more planets placed on the left side of the chart, this person is self-directed and self-motivated. These people tend to focus on developing themselves.

#### **RIGHT-SIDE DOMINANT PLACEMENTS**

### Are there more planets placed on the right side of the chart?

If there are more planets placed on the right side of the chart, this person is focused on relationships and others. They tend to be responsive to life and people, they are relationship driven and they take their cues from others when taking action.




#### **BALANCED PLACEMENTS**
